


One Key Question® - What's New?

- Refined and standardized OKQ® Certification training with ongoing quality improvement
 - Goal is to ensure fidelity to the model and ensure intervention is being used to increase patient-centered conversations about pregnancy desires and goals
 - Over the past year, we have provided training for 230 providers in 12 states.
 - Various settings: Title X, Home Visiting, FQHCs, Substance abuse/behavioral health, Community Health Workers, WIC, College/University Student Health Services, and other community based-settings

ONE KEY QUESTION®: RESEARCH

- One Key Question® is a screening tool to connect women to evidence-based practices: preconception care and contraception.
- There have been multiple pilot studies:
 - Provider and patient acceptability of question
 - Increase in contraceptive counseling, contraception prescriptions, and changing of methods
- Also assess confidence levels and training in pre/post of surveys
